HERE ARE SOME THINGS YOU NEED TO BE AWARE OF WHILE PROCESSING AT THE MEPS:

- No guns, knives or weapons.
- Pay close attention to all instructions given by the MEPS personnel.
- Obey all MEPS procedures.
- No horseplay or any behavior that may be disruptive or injure others.
- No profanity.
- No alcohol, drugs or drug paraphernalia.
- Don't bring valuables or large sums of cash with you to the MEPS.

AT THE HOTEL:

- Don't invite anyone into your room.
- Don't accept anyone else's invitation to their room.
- Avoid "pre-shipping out" parties.
- Read and follow posted hotel security rules.
- Don't give out your room number to those you do not know.
- Don't swim alone in the hotel pool.
- Keep your room key or key card with you at all times.

AT THE AIRPORT:

- Be on time.
- Follow all airport and airline security rules.
- Never volunteer to "watch" the baggage of someone you don't know.
- Maintain physical contact with your baggage at all times.
- Report any suspicious activity while in the MEPS or at the hotel.
