

San Antonio MEPS Important Information for Applicant Guests

San Antonio MEPS looks forward to welcoming you to witness your loved one take the Oath of Enlistment prior to shipping to basic training. Today they join an honored tradition of service to something greater, showing great selflessness, courage, and commitment just by volunteering to serve. We are honored to welcome them, and you, into the military family.

Our Oath of Enlistment ceremonies take place daily at 10:00 AM in the field across from the MEPS station (see below map). In the event of inclement weather, the ceremony will take place inside the MEPS.

Below you will find information about visiting San Antonio MEPS. Please read it in its entirety before your visit.

Viewing the Oath of Enlistment ceremony:

- Active-Duty applicants who are about to ship to basic training as well as National Guard and Reserve applicants are authorized *two* adult guests to attend their Oath of Enlistment. Guests under the age of 18 do not count toward an applicant's two visitors. Additional visitors require prior approval from the MEPS.
- In the event of inclement weather, guests are allowed in the MEPS 30-minutes prior to the ceremony.
- Applicants will contact their guests approximately 30 minutes prior to the Oath of Enlistment ceremony. Please remain nearby the MEPS to ensure timely arrival.
- Disruptive guests will be asked to leave.

- Requirements to get on base:

 - To enter unescorted, the applicant's recruiter <u>MUST</u> complete a
 "JBSANANTONIO Form 7" <u>NO LATER THAN</u> 10 days prior to ship date and
 submit it to the Fort Sam Houston Security general inbox at
 502SFS.VCC@us.af.mil.

Security

- In order to access Fort Sam Houston, a valid, physical or official digital I.D. (photos of I.D.s are not acceptable).
 - Acceptable Driver's License, State I.D., Passport, City I.D. (or other I.D. specified in UMR 601-23, available here)
 - o Minors must be accompanied by an adult. They do not require I.D.
- In the event of inclement weather, all guests will go through a security screening to include metal detector, X-ray machine, bag check in order to enter the MEPS.
 - To decrease check-in times, guests are encouraged not to bring bags.
- Guests must sign in and out on a visitor log while at the MEPS.

Photography

• Photos and videos are allowed. In the event of inclement weather, photos and videos are only authorized in the Oath Ceremony room while inside the MEPS.
