

Seattle MEPS Important Information for Applicant Guests

Seattle MEPS looks forward to welcoming you to witness your loved one take the Oath of Enlistment prior to shipping to basic training. Today they join an honored tradition of service to something greater, showing great selflessness, courage, and commitment just by volunteering to serve. We are honored to welcome them, and you, into the military family.

Below you will find information about visiting Seattle MEPS. Please read it in its entirety before your visit.

Viewing the Oath of Enlistment ceremony:

- Active-Duty applicants who are about to ship to basic training as well as National Guard and Reserve applicants are authorized *two* guests to attend their Oath of Enlistment.
- Guests are allowed in the MEPS 30-minutes prior to the ceremony. Oath times vary throughout the day.
- Applicants will contact their guests approximately 60 minutes prior to the Oath of Enlistment ceremony. Please remain nearby the MEPS to ensure timely arrival.
- Guests must exit the MEPS following the ceremony.
- Disruptive guests will be asked to leave.

Getting here

- Seattle MEPS is located in a federal building on a gated compound.
- The address is: Federal Central South Building

at 4735 E. Marginal Way S

Seattle, WA 98134

- Recruiting commands are responsible for escorting guests to the MEPS entrance. MEPS personnel will escort guests from Federal Building lobby to the MEPS.
- Guests will need a federal or state issued photo I.D. to get inside the federal building.

Parking

• Visitor parking is available near the entrance of the Federal Building and across the street in a large parking lot.

Security

- Provide a valid, physical I.D. (photos of I.D.s are not acceptable).
 - o Acceptable Driver's License, State I.D., Military/Retiree/Dependent ID, Passport



- o Minors must be accompanied by an adult. They do not require I.D.
- All guests will go through a security screening to include metal detector, X-ray machine, bag check. Guest bags will be scanned by security for contraband before entering. Please plan accordingly.
- To decrease check-in times, guests are encouraged not to bring bags.
- Guests must sign in and out on a visitor log and wear a visitor badge while at the MEPS.
