

Albuquerque MEPS Important Information for Applicant Guests

Albuquerque MEPS looks forward to welcoming you to witness your loved one take the Oath of Enlistment prior to shipping to basic training. Today they join an honored tradition of service to something greater, showing great selflessness, courage, and commitment just by volunteering to serve. We are honored to welcome them, and you, into the military family.

Below you will find information about visiting Albuquerque MEPS. Please read it in its entirety before your visit.

Viewing the Oath of Enlistment ceremony:

- Active-Duty applicants who are about to ship to basic training as well as National Guard and Reserve applicants are authorized *two* adult guests to attend their Oath of Enlistment. Guests under the age of 18 do not count toward an applicant's two visitors. Additional visitors require prior approval from the MEPS.
- Guests are allowed in the MEPS 30-minutes prior to the ceremony. Oath times vary throughout the day.
- Applicants will contact their guests approximately 30 minutes prior to the Oath of Enlistment ceremony. Please remain nearby the MEPS to ensure timely arrival.
- Guests must exit the MEPS following the ceremony.
- Disruptive guests will be asked to leave.

• Parking is available in front of the building.

Security

- Provide a valid, physical or official digital I.D. (photos of I.D.s are not acceptable).
 - Acceptable Driver's License, State I.D., Passport, City I.D. (or other I.D. specified in UMR 601-23, available here). A REAL ID is not required to enter the facility.
 - o Minors must be accompanied by an adult. They do not require I.D.
- All guests will go through a security screening to include metal detector, X-ray machine, bag check.
 - o To decrease check-in times, guests are not allowed to bring bags.
- Guests must sign in and out on a visitor log and wear a visitor badge while at the MEPS.

• There are no vending machines available for drinks and snacks. Guests are allowed to bring water in the facility.
