Lieutenant Colonel Stephen M. Mallory is the commander of 1st Battalion, United States Military Entrance Processing Command and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

He earned his commission in 2005 through Cornell University's Army Reserve Officer Training Corps while attending Ithaca College, Ithaca, New York.

Lieutenant Colonel Mallory most recently served as the professor of military science at Cornell University, United States Army Cadet Command, Ithaca, New York; board recorder, Department of the Army Secretariat, Fort Knox, Kentucky; director of Manpower, 8th Army, Camp Humphreys, Republic of Korea; deputy division human resources officer, 2nd Infantry Division, Camp Humphreys; commander, Portland Military Entrance Processing Station, Portland, Maine; brigade human resources officer, 2nd Engineer Brigade, U.S. Army Alaska, Joint Base Elmendorf Richardson, Alaska, and deployed to Afghanistan; operations officer, Portland MEPS, Portland, Maine; battalion human resources officer and headquarters detachment commander, 192nd Explosive Ordnance Disposal Battalion, 52nd Ordnance Group, 20th Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Explosives Command, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, and deployed to Iraq; and battalion human resources officer and company executive officer, 229th Military Intelligence Battalion, Defense Language Institute, the Presidio of Monterey, California.

His professional military education includes the Adjutant General Officer Basic Course, Adjutant General Officer Advanced Course, and Army Command and General Staff College. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Photography from Ithaca College, and a Master of Business Administration from the University of Tennessee, Knoxville.
