His professional military education includes the Aerospace Basic Course, Squadron Officer School, and Air Command and Staff College. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Meteorology from Iowa State University, Ames; and a Master of Arts in Homeland Security from the American Military University, Charles Town, West Virginia.
