Major Monique M. Pullin is the commander of the Anchorage Military Entrance Pro-cessing Station.

She enlisted in the Army in December 1996, and attended Basic Combat Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina, and served as an automated logistics specialist with the Army National Guard's B Company, 230th Brigade Support Battalion, Dunn, North Carolina, and deployed in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom.

Major Pullin received her commission as an Adjutant General Officer in May 2007 and served as platoon leader and operations officer, Theater Accountability Headquarters Support Team, 510th Human Resource Company, Fort Eustis, Virginia, deploying to Iraq; battalion administration officer and adjutant to the battalion commander, 3rd Psychological Operation Battalion, Fort Bragg, North Carolina; commander, Columbus Recruiting Company, Ohio; recruiting battalion administration officer and battalion operations officer, Columbus Recruiting Battalion; future operations officer, Eighth Army Human Resources Plans and Operations, Yongsan, Republic of Korea; and brigade administration officer, 4th Cavalry Multi-Functional Training Brigade, Fort Knox, Kentucky.



Her professional military education includes the Recruiting Operations Officer Course, Re-cruiting Company Leadership Course, Adjutant General Captains Career Course, Basic Officer Leaders Course III, and Adjutant General Officer Basic Course II. She earned a Bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice from the University of North Carolina, Pembroke.
