Commander Liberato served as an electronic warfare officer aboard the Whidbey Island-class dock landing ship USS Rushmore, homeported in San Diego, California; training officer aboard the Arleigh Burke-class destroyer USS Howard, homeported in San Diego; fleet watch officer for the Commander, Third Fleet, San Diego; assistant officer in charge, Personnel Support Detachment Afloat West, San Diego; administrative officer, Camp Lemonnier, Djibouti, Africa; officer in charge, Transient Personnel Unit, Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; commander, Springfield Military Entrance Processing Station, Massachusetts; and workforce development officer, Navy Region Europe Africa Central, Naples, Italy.
