Major David J. Winslow

Maj. David J. Winslow is the commander of the Fargo Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

He processed through the Fargo MEPS and earned his commission through the Officer Candidate School in August 2004 and commissioned May 2005 after graduating from the University of North Dakota.

He served as the supply officer, Headquarters and Service Company, 2nd Battalion, 10th Marines, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina, and deployed to Afghanistan October 2009 to May 2010. He served as 6th Engineer battalion inspector and instructor staff logistics officer, supply officer and Headquarters and Service Company Commander from June 2010 to June 2013 in Portland, Oregon. Upon transfer to Marine Air Support Squadron 3, Marine Air Control Group 38, 3d Marine Aircraft Wing, Camp Pendleton, California, Maj. Winslow served as the squadron supply officer, logistics officer, Headquarters and Service Company Commander and Squadron Executive Officer from June 2013 to May 2017. He also deployed to Afghanistan December 2013 to July 2014 as the supply and logistics officer for Marine Air Control Group 38. In 2017, Maj. Winslow transferred to 1st Marine Headquarters Group, 1st Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Pendleton, California, where he served as the supply officer until July 2017. He served as the group supply officer and Personnel Support Detachment commanding officer for Marine Air Control Group 28, 2nd Marine Aircraft Wing, Cherry Point, North Carolina from August 2017 to June 2020. He was forward deployed as the logistics officer and supply officer for Special Purpose Marine Air Ground Task Force Crisis Response Africa from October 2018 to April 2019. Maj. Winslow served as the operations officer and Company B commanding officer, Marine Corps Security Force Battalion, Marine Security Force Regiment, Naval Base Kitsap, Bangor, Washington from July 2020 to June 2023.

Maj. Winslow's professional military education includes the Officer Candidate School, The Basic School, Naval Aviation Flight Training, Supply Officer Career Course, Expeditionary Warfare School, Intermediate MAGTF Logistics School, and Command and Staff College. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Aerospace from the University of North Dakota at Grand Forks, North Dakota.

His military awards and decorations include the Meritorious Service Medal, four Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medals, Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medal, and various unit and service medals and ribbons.
