Major Schmidt served as deputy and service program manager, Airmen and Family Services Division, Air Force Installation Mission Support Center, and also section commander, Headquarters, 16th Air Force, both at Joint Base San Antonio, Texas; operations officer, New York MEPS, Fort Hamilton, New York; force development flight commander, 86th Force Support Squadron; and also sexual assault response coordinator, 86th Airlift Wing, both at Ramstein Air Base, Germany; command sponsorship program manager, 379th Expeditionary Mission Support Group, Al Udeid Air Base, Qatar; manpower requirements flight commander, 3d Manpower Requirements Squadron, deputy operations officer, officer in charge of Training and Plans, and chief of Force Management, 375th Force Support Squadron, all at Scott Air Force Base, Illinois.

His military education includes the Air and Space Basic Course, Force Support Officers Couse, Squadron Officers School and the Air Command and Staff College.
