Lieutenant Commander Porsha J. Lorick is the commander of the Honolulu Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

She received her commission through Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps at Florida A&M University, Tallahassee, in 2013.

Lieutenant Commander Lorick served as combat information center division officer and main propulsion officer aboard USS Sampson, homeported in San Diego, California, and deployed to 7th Fleet Area of Operations; training officer aboard USS Comstock, homeported in San Diego, California, and deployed to 5th Fleet Area of Operations; manpower and personnel analyst, Naval Research Laboratory, Washington, D.C.; and protocol officer to the Chief of Naval Personnel, Arlington, Virginia.

Lieutenant Commander Lorick's military education includes the Navy's Senior Leader Legal Course, Command Leadership Course, Intermediate Leadership Course, and the Human Resources Introductory Course.
