Commander Richard M. Yates is the commander of 10th Battalion and Jacksonville Military Entrance Processing Station, and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

He enlisted in the Marine Corps at Baltimore MEPS in 1997 and attended Marine Corps Recruit Boot Camp, Parris Island, South Carolina, and Marine Corps Combat Training, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina. He received his commission from the United States Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland, in 2006.

His enlisted assignments include avionics technician, in both Avionics "A" School, Pensacola, Florida, and Avionics "C" School, Cherry Point, North Carolina; and avionics technician, AV-8B Harriers, Marine Attack Squadron 223, Cherry Point.
