Maj. Aaron M. Wellman is the commander of the Louisville Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

He earned his commission through Officer Candidate School, Marine Corps Base Quantico, Virginia, in 2007.

Maj. Wellman served as incident response platoon commander, Marine Wing Support Squadron-273, Marine Corps Air Station Beaufort, South Carolina; military police platoon commander, Marine Wing Support Squadron-271, Marine Corps Air Station Cherry Point, North Carolina, and deployed to Combat Outpost Trebil, Iraq; district officer in charge and assistant operations officer, consolidated Provost Marshal Office for Marine Corps Air Station Beaufort and Marine Corps Recruit Depot Parris Island, South Carolina; executive officer, academics officer and course officer in charge of the Military Police Officer Basic Course, Military Police Instruction Company, Marine Corps Detachment, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri; company commander, 1st Law Enforcement Battalion, Camp Pendleton, California and deployed to Helmand province, Afghanistan; deputy current operations officer, Marine Forces Northern Command, New Orleans, Louisiana; and provost marshal, Marine Corps Installations National Capital Region-Marine Corps Base Quantico, Virginia.
