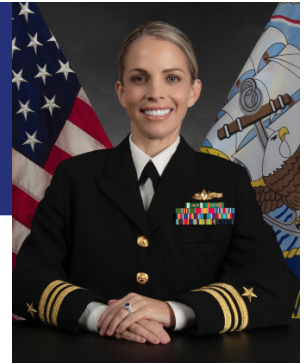

Lieutenant Commander Theresa M. Ramsey is the commander of the Memphis Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

She enlisted in the Navy at the San Diego MEPS and earned her commission through Officer Candidate School in May 2010.

She served as the main propulsion and electrical division officer aboard the guided missile cruiser USS Chancellorsville, San Diego, California; assistant staff operations officer, Amphibious Squadron Five, homeported in San Diego; amphibious warfare syndicate, Tactical Training Group Pacific, San Diego; flag aide, Navy Region Southwest, San Diego; operations officer, Navy Talent Acquisition Group Pacific, Los Angeles, California; navy fellow, Secretary of the Navy Tour with Industry, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, Memphis, Tennessee; and branch head for Enlisted Distribution, Navy Personnel Command, Millington, Tennessee. She also served on operational tours at sea with deployments as part of the Ronald Reagan Strike Group.

Lieutenant Commander Ramsey's professional military education includes the Senior Leader Legal Course, Command Leadership Course, Human Resources Introductory and Intermediate Leadership Course, Joint Maritime Tactics Course, Surface Warfare Officer School and Joint Professional Military Education. She earned a Bachelor of Arts from California State University, Fullerton; and a Master of Business Administration from the University of Phoenix. She is a qualified Surface Warfare Officer, Certified Professional in Human Resources, and a subspecialist in resource management and analysis.
