Lieutenant Commander Matthew Faber is the commander of the Memphis Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of the Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

He received his commission through Naval Reserve Officers Training Corps at Jacksonville University, Florida in 2014.

Lt. Cmdr. Faber served as the electrical officer aboard USS O'kane, homeported in Pearl Harbor, Hawaii; force protection/safety officer aboard USS Mccampbell, homeported in Yokosuka, Japan; flag aide, Deputy Chief of Naval Operations for Operations, Plans and Strategy; Washington D.C.; manpower analyst, Navy Manpower Analysis Center, Millington, Tennessee.
