Eisenhower, homeported in Norfolk, Virginia and deployed to 5th Fleet Area or Operations; 900 division leading chief petty officer, Fleet Readiness Center South East, Jacksonville, Florida; quality assurance supervisor and leading chief petty officer aboard USS Ronald Reagan, forward deployed to Yokosuka, Japan and deployed to 6th Fleet Area of Operation; aviation support equipment technician rating detailer, Naval Personnel Command, Millington, Tennessee.
