## Command Senior Chief Adam W. Ellis

Command Senior Chief Petty Officer Adam W. Ellis is the Senior Enlisted Advisor of Milwaukee, Wisconsin Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

He enlisted in the United States Navy at the Lansing MEPS in May 2002.

Upon completion of Recruit Training Command, Great Lakes, Illinois, and Master-at-Arms "A" School in Virginia Beach, Virginia, he reported to Naval Magazine Pearl Harbor. He deployed with Embarked Security Team CC25 in 2004 in support of Operation Vigilant Mariner, followed by an assignment to Mobile Security Squadron Two Detachment 23 in Little Creek, Virginia, where he conducted small boat operations, high-value asset escorts, and detained operations in Guantanamo Bay, Cuba and earned his Expedition Warfare device.

In 2008, he completed Military Working Dog Handler Course and earned the DOD "Top Dog" award. He deployed in 2009 to Mosul, Iraq with the U.S. Army, supporting over 50 combat missions. He subsequently served as kennel supervisor at NAS Oceana and Naval Submarine Base New London, where he supported numerous Secret Service missions and earned multiple qualifications to include antiterrorism tactical watch officer and watch commander. He later served as lead trainer at NSA Bahrain, Operations Chief and Kennel Master at NAS Kingsville, Regional MWD Trainer for Commander, Navy Region Northwest, and Kennel Master at Naval Base Kitsap. In 2022, he reported to Joint Base Pearl Harbor-Hickam as the kennel master, and later serving as Security's Senior Enlisted Advisor and Installation's acting Command Senior Enlisted Leader. In 2025, he transferred to CNIC Headquarters where he served as the Senior Enlisted Advisor and NSF assessor for the Assessment, Training and Evaluation Detachment.

He is a graduate of the U.S. Navy Senior Enlisted Academy (Class 277 Green) and the Command Master Chief/Chief of the Boat Course (25130).

His personal awards include five Navy Commendation Medals, Army Commendation Medal, Air and Space Commendation Medal, five Navy and Marine Corps Achievement Medals and various service, unit, campaign and personal ribbons.
