Senior Chief Petty Officer Pickle is the senior enlisted advisor of the Nashville Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

He enlisted in the Navy in July 1999 at the Richmond, Virginia, (now Fort Lee) MEPS, and completed basic training at Recruit Training Command, Naval Station Great Lakes, Illinois.

He served as work center supervisor aboard the Nimitz-class aircraft carrier, USS George Washington, homeported in Virginia Beach, Virginia; 2nd Division leading petty officer aboard the Raleigh-class amphibious transport dock, USS La Salle, homeported in Gaeta, Italy; trainer, Training Support Center, Naval Station Great Lakes; Detachment One boat captain, Riverine Squadron One, Little Creek, Virginia; Detachment Alpha leading chief petty officer, Mobile Expeditionary Security Squadron Two, Portsmouth, Virginia; mobility seamanship team lead, Afloat Training Group Pacific Northwest, Everett, Washington; Operations Department leading Chief Petty Officer aboard the Arleigh Burkeclass destroyer, USS Sampson, homeported in Everett; and 1st lieutenant leading chief petty officer, Naval Base Ventura County, Point Mugu, California
