Lieutenant Commander Joel D. Pagán is the commander of the Oklahoma City Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service. He earned his commission through Officer Candidate School in Newport, Rhode Island in October 2011.

Lieutenant Commander Pagán served as the 1st lieutenant aboard the Arleigh Burke-class guided-missile destroyer USS Gridley, homeported in San Diego, California; damage control assistant aboard the Wasp-class amphibious assault ship USS Iwo Jima, homeported in Jacksonville, Florida; officer recruiter and division officer, Navy Recruiting District Miami, Florida; company naval gunfire liaison officer, 5th Air Naval Gunfire Liaison Company, Camp Hansen, Okinawa; and operations officer, El Paso MEPS, Fort Bliss, Texas.
