## First Sergeant Ashely Flores

1st Sgt. Ashely Flores is the Senior Enlisted Advisor of the Oklahoma City Military Entrance Processing Station and supports the USMEPCOM mission of evaluating applicants by applying Department of Defense standards in processing and determining eligibility for military service.

First Sergeant Flores enlisted in the United States Army Reserve in February 2001, and completed Basic Training at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, and Advanced Individual training in Fort Jackson, South Carolina. In April 2003 she came on Active Duty.

Her first assignment was to Hunter Army Airfield, Georgia, where she was assigned to Headquarters and Headquarters Detachment, 559th Quartermaster Battalion, where she served as a personnel administration specialist. In June 2006 she was assigned to Osan Airbase Korea, where she served with 35th Air Defense Artillery Brigade as their human resources sergeant. In July 2009 she was assigned to Grafenwoehr, Germany, where she served with 4th Platoon 38th HR Company as the postal sergeant. In June 2010 she was assigned to Headquarters, 709th MP BN, East Camp Germany, where she served as a human resources sergeant. In June 2012 she was assigned to RHHT 3rd Cavalry Regiment, Fort Hood TX, where she served as the operations NCOIC. In December 2012 1st Sgt. Flores was assigned to Fox Company 3rd BN 13TH INF REGT, Fort Jackson, South Carolina, where she served as a drill sergeant. In February 2017 she was assigned to 210th Brigade Support Battalion, Fort Drum, New York, where she served as the senior human resources sergeant. Following this assignment in July 2020, she was reassigned to the United States Army Human Resources Command where she served as a senior HR liaison sergeant and a train-the-trainer for IPPS-A. Currently, she serves as the first sergeant for the Oklahoma City Military Entrance Processing Station.

1st Sgt. Flores' professional military education includes the Master Leaders Course, Senior Leaders Course, Drill Sergeant Academy, Advanced Leaders Course, and the Warrior Leaders Course.

Her military awards and decorations include two Meritorious Service Medals, five Army Commendation Medals, eight Army Achievement Medals, the MG Horatio Gates Bronze Medal, the COL Robert L. Manning Achievement Medal, numerous units, service medals and ribbons. First Sergeant Flores was also awarded the Drill Sergeant Badge as well as the German Armed Forces Badge of Marksmanship Schutzenschnur in Gold.
