Commander Jeremy N. Hyler is the commander of the 5th Battalion, United States Military Entrance Processing Command and the Seattle Military Entrance Processing Station.

He was selected for the Broadened Opportunity for Officer Selection Program and earned his commission through the ROTC program at the University of Washington, Seattle, in 2004.

Commander Hyler served as an electronic equipment technician aboard the ballistic missile submarine, USS Henry M. Jackson, homeported in Bangor, Washington; student naval aviator, Naval Flight Training, Pensacola, Florida; graduate student, Naval Postgraduate School, Monterrey, California; and served as recruiting operations officer, Naval Recruiting District Seattle, Washington; commanding officer, Transient Personnel Unit Puget Sound, Bangor; operations support officer, Navy Region Northwest, Bangor; and was a graduate student at the U.S. Army War College, Carlisle, Pennsylvania.

He earned a Bachelor of Science of Psychiatry and Behavior Science from the University of Washington; and attended the Naval Postgraduate School earning a Master of Science degree in Management (Manpower Systems Analysis) and the Army War College earning a Master's degree in Strategic Studies.
