

How USMEPCOM is combating COVID-19

- Everyone entering a Military Entrance Processing Station (MEPS) must undergo a temperature check and answer a screening questionnaire
- Required mask wearing and maintaining six feet of social distancing
- Providing personal protective equipment as needed
- Hand sanitizer available in the MEPS
- Only mission essential personnel are allowed in the MEPS
- Limit of one applicant per hotel room
- Transportation at 50 percent capacity in order to maintain social distancing
- Extensive contact tracing
- Deep cleanings of MEPS on routine schedule

In addition to USMEPCOM's efforts, recruits will be tested for COVID-19 upon their arrival at Initial Entry Training (basic training)



Servicemembers, employees, and applicants wear masks when interacting at MEPS.
