- More secure & scalable system


### Final Project Phase to Deployment

**September – November 2020** Build/test data interfaces with external systems

**December 2020 – January 2021** “Load test” USMIRS 1.1 in production and system interfaces

**March 2021** USMIRS 1.1 Minimum Viable Product at all MEPS

**April – June 2021** Sunset Legacy MIRS



## TESTING



### Alternative Device Study

- Expand the types of electronic devices (e.g., tablets, smart phones) to administer the ASVAB iCAT and PiCAT/PiCAT verification tests
- Pilot complete/data analysis in progress
- Initial steps for interface design and IT programing underway

FY22 – Beyond funding still required

### Special Purpose Test Migration

- Provides increased flexibility to access special purpose tests by migrating delivery from the WinCAT servers to the DMDC web platform to the cloud
- Will enable completion of special purpose tests at remote testing sites, thus decreasing applicant traffic in the MEPS

### iCAT ASVAB Delivery

- Supports DA data center consolidation by delivering the enlistment ASVAB via the Internet Computer Adaptive Test (iCAT) platform
- All services now testing on iCAT platform (Navy transition pending CS transition to iCAT)

## MEDICAL PROCESSING



Supported by Defense Healthcare Management System Modernization and Defense Health Agency

### HAIMS “Packetless”

**October – December 2020**

- Supports digitization of accession health records by providing the DoD Military Health System access to electronic DoD health documentation
- Significantly reduces exposure of Personally Identifiable Information and Protected Health Information
- Phase 1 of pilot underway

### Medical Review of Authoritative Data “Paperless”

**January – April 2021**

- Integrate authoritative medical information during Prescreening to better inform Medical Exams
- Includes DoD’s Joint Legacy Viewer and consumer reporting agencies as part of a Prescription Medication Reporting System
- Initiative reduces sole reliance on applicant self-disclosure

### MHS GENESIS “All Digital”

**August – December 2021**

- Next generation DoD electronic health record for accession through retirement
- Leverages authoritative data and reduces reliance on paper-based processes to improve:
  - ◆ qualification decisions
  - ◆ initial military training attrition
  - ◆ accession policy formulation
  - ◆ readiness and lethality
